1. editor

- noun
 - someone who makes written work ready for publication by correcting errors, revising, etc.
 - *gave the editor her story*

2. excellent

- adjective
 - extremely high in quality; superb
 - *an excellent dinner*
-

3. exception

- noun
 - a case not conforming to the accepted rules
 - *the exception to the rule*
-

4. excessive

- adjective
 - greater than what is reasonable, normal, or proper
 - *excessive exercise*
-

5. executive

- adjective
 - 1. relating to an executive, a person who manages or administrates in an organization *an executive meeting*
 - 2. having the responsibility and power to put laws into effect *executive decision*

6. effective

- adjective
 - producing the result that is desired
 - *an effective exercise*
-

7. benefits

- verb, noun
 - to provide help to, be beneficial to; an advantage
 - *benefit his ability to learn*
-

8. decimal

- noun
 - a number written in base 10; a number containing a decimal point
 - *a decimal fraction*
-

9. senator

- noun
 - a member of governing council
 - *if the senator voted for the law*
-

10. register

- verb, noun
 - v-to sign up for something, such as classes, contests, etc *will register for online classes*
 - n-a book for an official list of names, items, etc. *signed the register*
-

11. recognize

- verb
 - to know or be able to identify because of past experience or learning
 - *can recognize his former teacher*
-

12. restaurant

- noun
 - a building, room, etc., where the public can purchase meals
 - *ate at a Chinese restaurant*
-

13. plentiful

- adjective
 - relating to something in ample supply; more than enough
 - *plentiful sunlight for the garden*
-

14. temperature

- noun
 - the degree of cold or heat
 - *body temperature*
-

15. regret

- noun, verb
 - n-a feeling of sorrow for wrongdoing
regret for his actions
 - v-to feel sad or sorry about
will regret my mistake
-

16. professor

- noun
 - a teacher; an instructor
 - *a lecte* by a famous professor
-

17. misspell

- verb
 - to spell a word incorrectly
 - *will misspell two worlds*
-

18. memories

- noun
 - events remembered from the past
 - *memories of childhood*
-

19. memorable

- adjective
 - remarkable; unforgettable
 - *a memorable concert*
-

20. memorial

- adjective
 - honoring the memory of a special event or person
 - *a memorial statue*
